Boddingtons Pub Ale

Brewed at the Strangeways Brewery in Manchester, England since 1778, Boddingtons Pub Ale is an authentic English Bitter. It pours with initial “clouding” that clears slowly to produce a unique, pale golden colour and thick, creamy head. It is often referred to as “The Cream of Manchester”.



Stella Artois

A bottom fermented blonde lager that has a full distinctive taste and is brewed with the finest barley and hops. A slight hoppy start ends with a smooth, clean finish. Stella Artois is considered “Europe's Gold Standard Lager”.



Guinness Stout

Guinness is imported from St. James's Gate Brewery in Dublin, Ireland, where it's been brewed since 1759. Contrary to popular belief, it is to be served between 3 and 5 degrees Celsius.



Kilkenny Irish Cream Ale

Kilkenny brewing dates back to 1710 on the site of St. Francis Abbey in Kilkenny, Ireland. Today it is craft brewed in the oldest operating brewery in Ireland.



Newcastle Brown Ale

Newcastle Brown Ale is the authentic English Ale. Distinctly mahogany in colour, it's full-bodied malty flavour and subtle sweetness is full of flavour, yet refreshingly easy to drink.
